

Dear Course Provider,

NEBOSH are currently working in partnership with the Charities Safety Group on a scheme that offers scholarships to students from charitable and voluntary sector organisations for the NEBOSH National General Certificate qualification.

The Charities Safety Group will nominate a specific charity (group, institution or organisation) to receive one free place on a course leading to the examination for the award of the NEBOSH National General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety. The nominated charity are free to choose one of their employees or volunteers to receive this training.

The intention of the scheme is to enable charities and voluntary organisations to acquire health, safety and welfare competencies for their existing workers where, without sponsorship, they could not afford to do so. For this reason the scheme is aimed at smaller organisations and those who do not employ a Safety Practitioner. It is these organisations that will be given preference in the selection process.

It is NEBOSH's role to find a Course Provider who will train, free of charge, one person from a group, institution or organisation nominated by the Charities Safety Group. The Course Provider would waive fees and costs related to tuition and examinations (including not more than one resit, if legitimately required) and any fees payable to NEBOSH for examination registration would be waived.

All parties involved including NEBOSH and the Charities Safety Group will be willing to make themselves available for reasonable, and mutually beneficial, publicity and promotion attendant upon this arrangement, including the taking of photographs for publication.
